CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Day One Championship fee of \$30.00 **must** be paid on the first day of the event. The fee for subsequent days is \$20.

The Championship events will be conducted in three (3) grades in both Scratch and Nett. **“A”** (up to 12 handicap) **“B”** (13 to 18) **“C”** (19 to 36)

Junior (18 and under) and Senior (55 and over) championships will be held in conjunction with the above events. **“A” Reserve** – See separate notice.

Eligibility: Only Full Playing members (7 day members) are eligible to enter the Championships.

Timesheets will be available on the touch screens as follows. Players must book in for the first round. At 1pm on the first day, championship players will be allocated to the timesheet for round 2 after which non-championship players may book. Players must book in for each of rounds 3 & 4 separately. The top 8 players in each grade will be allocated to seeded groups in the round 4 timesheet. Players in the seeded part of this draw **must play at the time allocated.**

Non-Championship players may play on any championship day that their membership category allows them. They must pay their competition fee on the day.

In the event of a tie for the scratch winner in each grade, a play-off will be conducted. The Match Committee will determine the holes to be played. If still equal after the determined holes have been played, sudden-death will commence at the next play-off hole. In the event of a tie for the handicap winner and runner-up in each grade and the scratch runner-up in each grade, a count-back will be used. All count-backs will be: final 18 holes, then 3rd round, then 2nd round. If still equal, the back nine of the final round will be used.

The player's grade at the start of the first round will be maintained throughout the championships for calculation of scratch winner and runner-up in each grade. The player's handicap at the start of the first round will be used to determine handicap winner and runner-up in each grade. Handicap adjustments during the championships will be taken into account for the calculation of the competition on each day.

The Match Committee has the right to determine the number of rounds that will constitute the championship in each grade. Note that no reserve days have been scheduled. All disputes will be determined by the Match Committee on the day the incident occurs, prior to the announcement of winners.

NOTE: All members may use motorized transport during this event. (Pending weather conditions).
